DOOR - TO - DOOR SERVICE

Community Support Services - Central Intake Oxford County

Connects Oxford County residents to door - to - door accessible and non-accessible transportation service providers for those ages 55+ or 18+ with disabilities. In your area transportation services may include assistance to:

- Medical Appointments
- Grocery Shopping
- Adult Day Programs
- Social Outings

Mon - Fri 8:30am - 4:30pm

No referral is needed. Fees for services will apply.
