HEALTH CARE CONNECT

Register with Health Care Connect

Step 1: Get on the wait list. Register yourself and/or your whole family for Health Care Connect and a care connector will search for a Doctor or Nurse Practitioner who is accepting new patients in your community.

How to Register with Health Care Connect

Option 1: Register Online

- Click "Register with Health Care Connect"
- Follow the instructions to complete the online registration form
- Submit your application

Option 2: Register by Phone

- Call: 1-800-445-1822 (available Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.)
- A representative will help you complete the registration over the phone

What You'll Need to Register:

- Your Ontario Health Card
- Your contact information (phone number, address, email)
- Information about your current health needs or preferences

Once you're registered, Health Care Connect will keep you on the waitlist and contact you when a match becomes available in your area.

A program for children aged 0-5 years old who do not have current access to primary care.

Clinics held in Ingersoll, Tillsonburg, and Woodstock.

The program is here to assist families and their children with:

- The regular schedule of Well Baby Checks
- Maintaining their child's vaccination schedule
- Developmental screening for physical and mental health
- Resource navigation
- Dietary support

They do NOT provide acute care to acute illnesses (i.e ear infections, coughs, colds, vomiting etc.), care for children 6 years or older, or pregnancy care

Oxford Homelessness and Addiction and Recovery Treatment (HART) Hub

The Oxford HART Hub is a coordinated network of local organizations working together to provide mental health, addiction, housing, and social supports for adults ages 18+ in Oxford County. The Oxford HART Hub includes the Wellness Centre, that provides voluntary, 24/7, voluntary residential addiction recovery-focused treatment so people get the right help at the right time, close to home.

What's included in the HART Hub?

- 24/7 Central Intake and System Navigation
- Voluntary Residential Treatment at a Wellness Centre
- Mental Health & Addictions Services, including Outpatient Group Therapy
- Mobile Outreach Teams
- Transitional Housing and Social Supports
- Primary Care
- Wraparound Services to Support a Full Continuum of Care

Ontario Structured Psychotherapy (West Region)

Individuals who are over 18 years of age with depression, anxiety, or related symptoms (such as specific fears, obsessive compulsive concerns, or post-traumatic stress) may be eligible for free Cognitive Behavioural Therapy, in-person or online.
